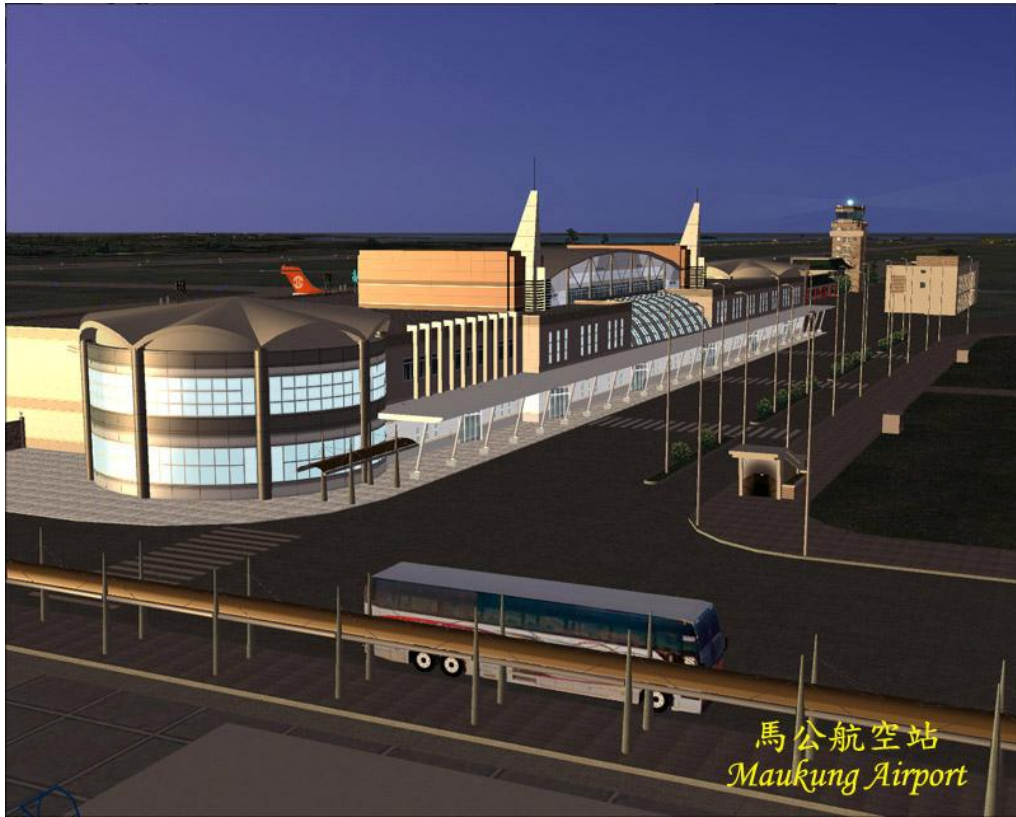


El Formosa - Taiwan Scenery Project Part 6



1. Introduction

Makung airport (RCQC) is situated on Makung Island, which is the largest island of the Penghu archipelago. With its beautiful natural resources and attractive sunshine, Penghu is one of the most popular resorts in Taiwan. Makung airport serves around one hundred flights per day, which is one of the busiest domestic airports in Taiwan. In this package, we provide high quality Gmax airport with several improvements on surrounding areas. Furthermore, you will enjoy your flight over the Penghu islands with Part2 installed!! Require el_formosa_part1.zip.

2. Features

1. For FS2004 Only.
2. Whole new GMAX Makung Airport (RCQC), including all terminals, tower, radar, military bunkers, parking lots, AFCAD and more. All based on real airport layout. Add three light towers to outside islands.
3. Makung harbor improvements including landmark building, Rainbow Bridge, Trans-Ocean Bridge and coastline updates.
4. Modify landclass and waterclass for Penhu archipelago.
5. Active approach procedures for Makung Airport.
6. Patch landclass in Taiwan and add cities to Hualien and Taitung.

3. Installation

1. Before installation, please make sure you have correctly installed Taiwan Scenery Part1 previously. This scenery does NOT compatible with default ones. Please download it from AVSIM. (File name is el_formosa_part1.zip)
2. There are three folders in the zip file. They are TaiwanScenery, Replacement and RCQC. You will see seven files in the TaiwanScenery/scenery folder. Add and overwrite them into your Taiwan Scenery Part1 folder which should be

TaiwanScenery/scenery.

3. Go to fs9/scenery/asia/scenery folder, remove and backup AP979230.bgl first. Then replace this with the file provided in "Replacement".
4. Install RCQC in normal procedure:
 - a. Unzip RCQC folder to where you usually install FS scenery.
 - b. Add this folder to scenery library in FS scenery setting.
 - c. Restart FS9
5. DONE!!

4. Tour Guide

RCQC is basically a domestic airport. Most of the commercial flights take off from Taiwan. With Part2 installed you can take a flight to/from RCCM and RCWA by small prop aircrafts or use jets to commence a flight to/from Taiwan.
